## > Did He Serve? Researching Military Service Records

Even if your ancestors were too poor to own land or valuable belongings, chances are that one or more of them served in some arm of the US military within the past 200-plus years. Records reveal vital statistics, locales, health histories and often birth, marriage or death records. Class covers these and much more.

- The Civil War: More than 3 million men served and it provides an extraordinarily rich genealogical resource for researchers. Rick Sayre has had a 31-year Army career and knows military research.
- Rural Research: City research has many sources, but not so for our rural ancestors. The records are less plentiful and less obvious. Pam Sayre will share what we can work with in our rural family history research.
- Clues in Missouri Migration: Many Americans trace ancestry to Missouri, but lack clues as to where they lived <u>before</u> Missouri. This lecture explores the migration paths and geographic roots of settlers. Pam is a 5<sup>th</sup> generation Missourian! Your will enjoy her presentation style and expertise.
